


Star Baby

FABRICS: *Calendar Babies* by JOY ALLEN for Elizabeth's Studio LLC

1830 Multi (Block panel)—1 panel (3/4) yard
P416 Red Sparkle—1/8 yard
P416 Royal Sparkle—1/8 yard
P416 Light Blue Sparkle—1/8 yard
P416 Green Sparkle—1/8 yard
P416 Gold Sparkle—1/8 yard
P416 Orange Sparkle—1/4 yard
231 White (Multi dots)—1-1/4 yard
1828 Multi (Overall baby print for border)—3/4 yard
P416 Red Sparkle—1/2 yard for binding
Backing fabric—1-5/8 yard
Batting for 39-1/2 x 49-1/4" quilt top



CUTTING DIRECTIONS:

Block Panel: cut (twelve) 7" squares—position the 7" square so that the TOP of the 7" block is 3/8" ABOVE the word "August" (or whatever month). The writing at the bottom should be within the 1/4 seam allowance at the bottom. See diagram above.

Red, Royal, Lt. Blue, Green and Gold Sparkle: cut (ten) 3-3/4" squares each.

Orange Sparkle: cut (twelve) 3-3/4" squares


231 Multi dots: cut (twenty) 3-3/4" squares AND (thirty-one) 7" x 3-3/4" rectangles.

1828 Overall baby print: cut (four) 3-3/4" x WOF for the borders—if you have prewashed your fabric, you may need an additional strip to piece the long side borders

Red Sparkle binding fabric: cut (five) 2-1/2" x width of fabric binding strips

MAKING THE STAR POINT BLOCK:

Place one 3-3/4" green square on 7" x 3-3/4" multi dot rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the green fabric. Sew on the line. Trim 1/4 inch outside the sewn line. Press.



Repeat to add another green square to the opposite corner.

You will need a total of: (5) completed blocks each of green, gold, lt blue, red and royal, (6) orange.

ASSEMBLING THE QUILT:

Following diagram for placement, sew star point blocks, multi dot squares and large "baby" blocks together to form rows, then sew rows together to form top.



BORDERS:

Cut two of the 3-3/4" overall baby print border strips to 42-3/4" and add to the sides of the quilt. If you have prewashed your fabric, you may need to cut an additional strip to piece the side borders.

Cut the two remaining overall baby print strips to 39-1/2" and add to the top and bottom of the quilt.

FINISHING:

Layer with batting and backing fabric, quilt as desired. Use 2-1/2" binding strips to bind quilt.
